Horse Arrival Information

→ Arrival of horses before Wednesday, 6 September 2023 | 8.00 a.m. is not allowed!

1. Horses for the **CSI-Am** and for the **Swiss Championship Elite** must arrive at the showgrounds between 8.00 and 17.00 on Wednesday, 6 September 2023, because the horse inspection of these horses starts at 18.00;
2. For **CSI 2*** horses, an arrival slot can be reserved on Wednesday 6 September between 8.00 and 18.00;
3. For **CSI 4*** horses, an arrival slot may be reserved on Wednesday, 6 September, between 8.00 and 18.00; however, upon request, **and exclusively for this category of horses**, an arrival slot may also be reserved for Thursday, 7 September 2023, between 8.30 and 11.00 in the morning.

Arrival slot: Please book your arrival time slot in advance! The arrival procedure, which has been put in place to comply with the biosecurity measures required by the FEI, will take some time.

Therefore, participants are advised to plan well for the arrival of their horses. There are eight slots per hour. If you have not reserved an arrival time, your truck will be guided to the waiting area. The later the truck with the horses arrives during the Wednesday afternoon, the longer it may take to unload the horses. Trucks without a pre-reserved arrival time will be processed in the order in which they arrive. However, trucks with an arrival slot always have priority.

Examination on arrival: After unloading the truck, all horses (and their FEI passport) must first be presented to the veterinarians in the designated area (arrival examination, FEI Vet. Reg. Art. 1010; 1031) to check the following points:

- The horse's microchip to determine identity (using the Bluetooth chip reader and the FEI HorseApp);
- the athlete's self-declaration including the horse's rectal temperature for the 3 days prior to arrival at the competition (recorded in the FEI HorseApp);
- equine influenza vaccinations (FEI Vet. Reg. Art. 1003);
- the horse's rectal temperature is measured and recorded on the FEI Horse App;
- search for other signs of infectious diseases.

Important: No horse may enter the stables unless its groom/rider has the express permission of the CSI official veterinarians.

Swiss Championship Elite: If you are taking part in both the Swiss Championships Elite and the CSI 2* or CSI 4* and are using a horse or horses in Ascona that do not come from your own stable, you must inform us in advance (**before Friday, 1 September 2023**) by e-mail: petra.duerst@gmail.com, in order to comply with the new FEI rules for the stable allocation of horses for national competitions, during CSIs.

Traces: If you need documents for so-called "Traces" for one or more of your horses, to facilitate your onward travel after the event in Ascona, please let us know before your arrival and **no later than Tuesday, 5 September 2023, 18.00 hrs.** by e-mail: sophie.borgevents@hotmail.com, indicating the horse(s) concerned.

Parking: As the available parking space for horse trucks is relatively limited, the organising committee would appreciate it if you, as far as possible of course, transport horses combined in the same truck to Ascona. Due to local and cantonal environmental regulations, ground protection measures will be applied when parking the trucks. Therefore, parking may take a little longer than usual. We thank you in advance for your understanding.
